

APPLICATION FOR A MINING RIGHT IN TERMS OF SECTION 22 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT 28 OF 2002): MONAZITE AND NATURAL OIL: PORTION 1 OF THE FARM STEENKAMPS KRAAL NO.70: SITUATED IN THE MAGISTERIAL OF VANRHYNSDORP

1. This is to inform you that your abovementioned application for a mining right to mine **Monazite, excluding diamond and natural oil over portion 1 of the farm Steenkamps Kraal No.70** situated in the Magisterial District of Vanrhynsdorp has been granted in terms of section 23(1) of the abovementioned Act.
2. The Regional Office will prepare the final copies of the right to be signed. Note that the Regional Manager will approve the relevant Environmental Management Programme and sign the right on the **07 May 2010**.
3. In light of the afore-going, you are requested to please submit the following documents at the Regional Office. Please kindly contact the Regional Manager's office to confirm the date for the execution.
 - 3.1 An **original** Resolution of the applicant, identifying the authorized representative[s] to sign the right on behalf of your company, with the full details of the notary public;

- 3.2 A diagram prepared by a land surveyor **[6(six) originals]** in accordance with the requirements of the Mining Titles Registration Act, 1967;
 - 3.3 An acceptable financial provision for rehabilitation providing for an amount of **R 250 000.00** (if you did submit financial provision already, please enquire from the Regional Manager whether the quantum of such provision is adequate);
 - 3.4 Two copies of the Mining Work Programme
 - 3.5 Two copies of Social and Labour Plan
4. Please make arrangements for your notary public, authorized representative and a witness to execute the right on the 07 May 2010.
 5. Note further that –
 - 5.1 In terms of section 25(2)(a), the signed/executed mining right must be lodged for registration at the Mineral and Petroleum Titles Registration Office **not later than 30 days** from the date of execution;
 - 5.2. In terms of section 23(5) of the Act, the mining right comes into effect on the date on which the Environmental Management Programme is approved; and
 - 5.3 In terms of section 25(2) (b) the holder of a mining right must commence mining activities within one year of the effective date.
 6. **Failure to comply may result in the withdrawal, suspension or cancellation of right.**
